Dear Parents/Guardians of Sec 1, 2 and 3 students,

Time has really flown. We are now in the midst of Term 4. We would like to share some updates, and provide further details on this term, in particular, the post-exam schedule.

## New 21st Century Competencies (21CC) domain in EAGLES

The Ministry of Education has enhanced the Edusave Award for Achievement, Good Leadership and Service (EAGLES) to include a new 21CC domain, to recognise students' exemplary demonstration of competencies in both curricular and co-curricular settings.

At Loyang View, in line with our vision to develop future-ready leaders, we will focus on the demonstration of Adaptive Thinking and Communication Skills in students. Through various learning experiences, these students would exhibit confidence in ambiguity; resilience in pursuit of excellence; adaptability in changing contexts; and courage and tact in sharing.

#### **Financial Assistance Scheme for 2025**

We are pleased to inform you that the Ministry of Education Financial Assistance Scheme (MOE FAS) application for 2025 is now open to all Government and Government-aided Schools (GGAS). The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- a. Student is a Singaporean Citizen enrolled in a GGAS.
- b. Maximum Gross Monthly Household Income = \$3,000 or below OR
- c. Maximum Per Capita Income = \$750 or below (Per Capita Income = Total Gross Monthly Household Income divided by the No. of Household Members)

# Other important points to note:

- a. Students who are MSF ComCare recipients need not submit the application for MOE FAS as MOE FAS will be auto-granted to MSF ComCare beneficiaries in GGAS.
- b. You need to submit only one application form for all your GGAS children to one of their schools. The school which receives the application form will inform you of the outcome for all the children.

Student who meets the eligibility criteria and wish to apply may either:

- submit an online application for at <a href="https://go.gov.sg/moe-efas">https://go.gov.sg/moe-efas</a> or
- submit an online application form using the e-FAS form which is available on Parents Gateway (under Services tab Financial Assistance) via Singpass login or
- submit a hardcopy application as attached in this notification (hardcopy application forms are also available from the General Office)

An eligibility calculator is also available on the website should you wish to check whether your child is eligible for financial assistance.

Kindly submit your application early should you wish to apply for MOE FAS.

Parents and guardians are invited to attend the Parent-Teacher Meeting 3 (PTM 3) held on the last day of school, <u>Friday, 25 October from 1 p.m. to 4.30 p.m</u>. During this PTM session, you will be updated on your child's/ward's progress in school by his/her form teacher via a face-to-face meeting (preferred), zoom meeting or a phone call. The duration of each PTM session will be kept to 15 minutes. Booking of the session can be made via Parents Gateway from <u>12 p.m. on 21 October to 23 October</u>. If more time is needed, you may arrange separately with the Form Teacher for another session. If you do not wish to attend the PTM, there is no action required on your part. Should you wish to speak to a subject teacher, please email them separately.
